

Preventive Care covers things such as screenings, regular check-ups, and immunizations.

A Preventive Care visit will allow your doctor to assess your health and make sure you get the correct screening(s) for your age, gender, and family history. These visits aid in keeping you healthy and can help proactively identify health concerns before they potentially become a long-term condition.

### How will it be covered?

Many plans cover Preventive Care services without cost-sharing when you see a doctor that is in your health plan's network. Be sure to check your plan and the plan details before an appointment is made with a doctor.

Doctors will sometimes order tests during your Preventive Care visit that are not considered Preventative care, therefore resulting or subject to deductibles, co-pays and/or coinsurance.

# What is the difference between a Preventive visit and a routine office visit?

Preventive visits (also known as a routine checkup), are different than your traditional routine office visit scheduled for a specific medical issue.

Here, you will see your Doctor (or other health practitioners, such as a Nurse Practitioner or Physician's Assistant - PA) when you are healthy. This visit may include an exam, checking your blood pressure, getting recommended vaccines or health questions you may have.

- Will any additional tests or treatments I receive during my appointment not be considered preventive care?
- Will talking about other topics that are not considered preventive care during my appointment lead to out of pocket cost?
- Can any routine lab work be sent to a BlueCross BlueShield in network lab to lower any out of pocket cost?

Preventive care is covered at 100% when **1**) it is provided by an in-network doctor\*, **2**) the claim is filed as a preventive visit and **3**) services are identified as preventive care under the Affordable Care Act (ACA).\*
